

Basic Art Training – Sensory Exploration and Motor Skills Development (S\$35 per session -1.5hrs to 2 hrs)

Overall Objective:

The primary goal is to enhance sensory exploration, motor skills, and self-expression through the use of various art materials and techniques.

Learning Outcome

- 1. Identify and differentiate between various art materials and recognize primary colours and basic shapes.
- 2. Improve fine motor skills and enhance hand-eye coordination through drawing, painting, and crafting activities.
- 3. Explore textures, experiencing the sensory aspects of various art materials.
- 4. Express emotions and ideas through art, developing a sense of accomplishment and self-esteem in a collaborative environment.

Session (Different themes but similar objectives each week)

- Introduce different art supplies (paint, brushes, clay, paper, crayons, markers) and colours. Allow students to handle, explore and apply colours to materials.
- Teach basic drawing and painting techniques (brush strokes, colour mixing). Allowing students to create their own artwork using the techniques learned.
- Introduce materials of various textures for students to explore. Use different materials to create art/craftwork.
- Develop fine motor skills through the application of wet or dry mediums.
- Promote self-expression and creativity.



Creative Expression and Independence – Develop Higher Creative Ability & Basic Life Skills (S\$40 per session -1.5hrs to 2 hrs)

Objective:

Purposeful engagement. Engage and learn various art mediums to create products for an end-of-the-year pop-up flea market. Develop money handling and customer service skills to manage their own booth.

Qualifier:

We will be assessing students to determine their readiness for this course. While most students will be placed in their desired programs, there may be instances where some individuals are better suited for the Basic Art Training initially. We kindly request your understanding and patience during this process. The year-end, pop-up booth will feature items created and made by our students. All related cost of the event will be shared by the students and sales proceeds will be distributed back to the respective creators. Our aim, in collaboration with parents/caregiver, and our students, is to ensure that each student receives the best possible experience and outcome. Session:

- 1. Developing Art Skills: Participants will explore various art mediums, create and enhance art products, and learn techniques for professional finishes, preparing a portfolio for the booth.
- 2. Problem-Solving and Creativity: Participants will enhance problem-solving skills and creativity through creative exercises to improve products and artwork.
- 3. Complex Fine Motor Skills: Participants will develop advanced art techniques, precision, and control to create quality, professional-looking products.

- 4. Money Handling: Participants will engage in practical money handling exercises, manage transactions, and understand basic collection management.
- 5. Customer Service: Participants will develop effective customer service skills through role-playing scenarios, focusing on greeting customers, communication techniques, and handling queries.
- 6. Encouraging Independence: Participants will learn to set up, organize, and manage a pop-up booth independently, focusing on self-reliance and decision-making.
